Presentation: Liberty Utilities (Hanwell Industrial Park):

- Liberty Utilities bought Embridge Gas and has approximately 800,000 utility customers.
- Natural gas is 40% lighter than air: odourless and non-toxic
- Transmission lines start in Lincoln
- There is a 6" pipe going up Timothy Drive and Millenium Drive, with a line pressure of 80 PSI
- All customers have an access flow valve except Sewells Paving and Perfection Paving, but both have been updated. Perfection Paving is very proactive.
- Fire Department is trained to shut off valves (red handle)
- If there is an emergency Liberty Utilities will take control of the leak once on scene but full scene control will remain with the Upper Kingsclear Fire Department.
- During a storm and trees are down, be sure to think about the utilities.
