Jamie Burke of Stantec and Raghav Parikh and Sarah Hilborn of Capital Region Service Commission made a presentation with respect to By-Law #37-2026 - Hanwell Rural Community Plan which is a consolidation of By-Law 11-2016 and Kingsclear Planning Area Rural Plan Regulation 06-KNG-041-00 to establish a single, comprehensive plan for the new municipality. 28 residents were in attendance to voice their objections.

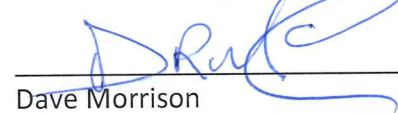
